



# **AZMON**



The hymn tune AZMON was composed by Carl G. Glaser in 1828. In 1839, Lowell Mason arranged the hymn tune which is common to most hymnals in the United States. The interesting, obscure, and unfamiliar name AZMON is the name of a city south of Canaan, which appears in Numbers 34:4.

Mason's arrangement of Glaser's melody is the dominant hymn tune used to sing *O For a Thousand Tongues to Sing* throughout the hymnody of mainline denominations in the United States. Originally a hymn of 18 stanzas, it was written by Charles Wesley (d.1788) to mark the anniversary of his conversion. His brother John selected verses for his *Collection of Hymns for Methodists*, beginning with stanza 7, giving us the well-known first line.

#### The original lyrics are:

- 1. Glory to God, and praise and love, Be ever, ever given; By saints below and saints above, The Church in earth and heaven.
- On this glad day the glorious Sun Of righteousness arose,
   On my benighted soul he shone,
   And filled it with repose.
- 3. Sudden expired the legal strife; 'Twas then I ceased to grieve. My second, real, living life, I then began to live.
- 4. Then with my heart I first believed, Believed with faith divine; Power with the Holy Ghost received To call the Saviour mine.
- 5. I felt my Lord's atoning blood Close to my soul applied; *Me, me* he loved - the Son of God For *me*. for *me* he died!
- 6. I found and owned his promise true, Ascertained of my part, My pardon passed in heaven I know, When written on my heart.

- 7. O For a thousand tongues to sing My dear Redeemer's praise! The glories of my God and King, The triumphs of His grace!
- 8. My gracious Master and my God, Assist me to proclaim, To spread through all the world abroad The honors of Thy name.
- 9. Jesus! the Name that charms our fears, That bids our sorrows cease; 'Tis music in the sinner's ears, 'Tis life, and health, and peace.
- 10. He breaks the power of cancell'd sin, He sets the prisoner free; His blood can make the foulest clean, His blood avail'd for *me*.
- 11. He speaks, and, listening to his voice, New life the dead receive; The mournful, broken hearts rejoice; The humble poor believe.
- 12. Hear him, ye deaf; his praise, ye dumb, Your loosen'd tongues employ; Ye blind, behold your Saviour come, And leap, ye lame, for joy.

- 13. Look unto him, ye nations; own Your God, ye fallen race; Look, and be saved through faith alone, Be justified by grace.
- 14. See all your sins on Jesus laid; The Lamb of God was slain; His soul was once an offering made For every soul of man.
- 15. Harlots, and publicans, and thieves, In holy triumph join!
  Saved is the sinner that believes,
  From crimes as great as mine.
- 16. Murderers, and all ye hellish crew, Ye sons of lust and pride, Believe the Savior died for you; For me the Saviour died.
- 17. Awake from guilty nature's sleep, And Christ shall give you light, Cast all your sins into the deep, And wash the Aethiop white.
- 18. With me, your chief, ye then shall know, Shall feel your sins forgiven; Anticipate your heaven below, And own that love is heaven.


General Piston registration suggestions:

- ① Foundations 8' and 4'
- ② Foundations 8', 4', 2'
- ③ Sw: Celestes; Gt: Solo stop, trem; Ped: soft 16'
- 4 Gt: Flutes 8', 2'; Sw: Flute 8' or 4'
- ⑤ Sw: Flutes and Strings 8'; Gt: Chimes; Ped: soft 16', 8'
- 6 Full to Mixtures
- 7 Add Reeds


